## **Smugglers Class**

Although I have been away with the Year 6's on their residential trip I know that the other year groups have been busy with their learning. Year 3, 4 and 5 have been completing a short acrostic Poetry module using the amazing 'The Lost Words' book. In Maths, we are have been learning multiplication methods. Year 3 and 4 have been using inverse operations to revise their times tables and Year 5 have been multiplying by 2 digit numbers.

The Science investigations this half term move onto the force of friction and then levers and pulleys. This will give the children lots of opportunities for practical experiments.

We continue with French as our foreign language. The children are making such good headway with their French that it seems sensible to increase our proficiency.

This week your children will all have home learning. For Years 3 and 4 this will be in the form of spellings and times table practice. Year 5 and 6 will have Maths, to reinforce learning completed at school and a simple spelling and grammar activity.
